

## Website privacy policy

This website is operated by Prime8 International Limited. We take your privacy very seriously therefore we urge to read this policy very carefully because it contains important information about on:

- who we are,
- how and why we collect, store, use and share personal information,
- your rights in relation to your personal information, and
- how to contact us and supervisory authorities in the event that you have a complaint.

### Who we are

Prime8 International Limited ('we' or 'us') collect, use and are responsible for certain personal information about you. When we do so we are regulated under the General Data protection Regulations which apply across the European Union (including the United Kingdom) and we are responsible as 'controller' of that personal information for the purposes of those laws.

### The personal information we collect and use

#### a) Personal information you provide to us

We collect the following personal information that you provide to us:

#### b) Personal information you provide about third parties

If you give us information about another person, you confirm that the other person has appointed you to act on their behalf and agreed that you:

shall consent on their behalf to the transfer of their personal data abroad.

### c) Monitoring and recording communications

We may monitor communications such as emails and telephone calls for the following purposes:

quality assurance, fraud prevention,

### **How we use your personal information**

We collect information about our users for the following purposes:

to ensure that we provide the correct service, product and information to our customers.

To promote new and relevant products to suitable customers

### **Who your information may be shared with**

We may share your information with:

Law enforcement agencies in connection with any investigation to help prevent unlawful activity

We will not share you personal information with any other 3rd parties.

### **Whether personal information has to be provided by you, and if so why**

No personal information has to be provided by you to us at any time.

### **How long your personal information will be kept**

We will hold your personal information for the following periods:

6 yeas to satisfy UK tax law

These periods are no longer than necessary in each case.

### **Reasons we can collect and use your personal information**

We rely on the following as the lawful basis on which we collect and use your personal information:

legal obligation

### **Consequence of our use of your personal information**

The consequence to you of our use of your personal information is:

### **Keeping your information secure**

We have appropriate security measures in place to prevent personal information from being accidentally lost, or used or accessed in an unauthorised way. We limit access to your personal information to those who have a genuine business need to know it. Those processing your information will do so only in an authorised manner and are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

We will also use technological and organisation measures to keep your information secure. These measures may include the following examples:

user account is controlled by a unique user name and password

We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so.

Indeed, while we will use all reasonable efforts to secure your personal data, in using the site you acknowledge that the use of the internet is not entirely secure and for this reason we cannot guarantee the security or integrity of any personal data that are transferred from you or to you via the internet. If you have any particular concerns about your information, please contact us using the details below.

### **Transfers of your information out of the EEA**

We will not transfer your personal information outside of the EEA at any time.

### **Children and the validity of consent**

Where we obtain consent from any user we will take reasonable steps to ascertain whether the user is over 13 years of age and whether the child is sufficiently informed to give valid

consent. If the user is not, parental consent will be required to provide consent for the processing of any personal information.

### **What rights do you have?**

Under the General Data Protection Regulation you have a number of important rights free of charge. In summary, those include rights to:

- fair processing of information and transparency over how we use your use personal information
- access to your personal information and to certain other supplementary information that this Privacy Notice is already designed to address
- require us to correct any mistakes in your information which we hold
- require the erasure of personal information concerning you in certain situations
- receive the personal information concerning you which you have provided to us, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to a third party in certain situations
- object at any time to processing of personal information concerning you for direct marketing
- object to decisions being taken by automated means which produce legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affect you
- object in certain other situations to our continued processing of your personal information
- otherwise restrict our processing of your personal information in certain circumstances
- claim compensation for damages caused by our breach of any data protection laws

If such are offered, please note that there may be some period after selecting to unsubscribe in which marketing may still be received while your request is being processed.

### **Use of Cookies**

A cookie is a small text file created by a website and stored in your computer as a way for the website to recognize you and keep track of your preferences. The two main types of cookie are the 'session cookie' that ensures optimum operation during your current visit and 'permanent cookies' that are stored on your hard drive and contains data and information that will, for example, enable quicker access and logon next time you visit the site.

The benefits of cookies are that as the website owner we are able to track and monitor performance, access information and tailor certain elements to suit your browsing and user habits. They also help us to compile aggregate data regarding site traffic so that we can optimise our service to all users.

Allowing the use of cookies does not give access to any personal data on your computer. They are there to help improve the overall experience of using the website. An example of how a cookie works is the automatic completion of a registration form. We will monitor IP address information against user login to ensure conformance to any agreements between the website user and Prime8 International.

Any information we obtain through the use of our cookies will be treated as your personal information and as such is governed by the remaining terms within the Privacy Policy.

You can decide not to allow cookies on your computer via your web browser settings however, doing this is likely to reduce the performance and you may not be able to access certain parts of the website and its associated programmes.
